INTRODUCTION

Semiahmoo Family Place (SFP) is a non-profit family resource and drop- in play center serving the South Surrey and White Rock area since 1991.

We provide a safe, fun, and semi-structured space for babies, toddlers, preschoolers, and their families to play and learn together. Parents and caregivers are given the opportunity to build on their skills, create relationships with others in the community, and engage with their children while supported by a team of competent, passionate individuals.

MISSION

To connect families through play.

GOALS

To provide a comfortable, safe, and stimulating environment at no or low cost to children and their families. To implement age-appropriate learning and social experiences for children while keeping them together and with their caregivers.

To reduce isolation of caregivers and children.

To provide equipment and supplies not accessible to most families individually.

To integrate all families regardless of income, race, or social structure.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

Happy greetings to our SFP families.

The past year was challenging in the sense that we did not have a permanent space for SFP to call home. We continued with our online programs and slowly started to offer in-person session at the parks keeping in line with pandemic protocols. While we did not have the equipment and furniture that made our play space such an interesting place to be in, our program facilitators have gone above and beyond what they have been used to doing to provide engaging programs at parks and with the use of technology.

While we have not actively solicited for private funding, MCFD has patiently supported us through the past months albeit not have a physical, permanent space. It is also with their help that we have been able to purchase new equipment for the play space.

As the year draws to a close, we are beyond excited to return to in-person programs at Kensington Prairie Community Centre. While our programs are slightly modified to keep our SFP community safe, we strive to still be the welcoming space the community knows us to be.
